Mining is important to my family, my community and the State. I am worried about my job prospects but more importantly my childrens future prospects of work in any technical field within NSW
It is unfair that an unelected part-time panel is putting jobs and investment at risk with no accountability to the NSW Government.

The Independent Planning Commission should be required to make decisions that are consistent with the policies of the elected government.

The Independent Planning Commission is adding unnecessary delays to planning timeframes and it should not duplicate the assessment processes of the Department of Planning and other agencies.

There are more than 7,000 local businesses across NSW that are supported by mining. Decisions by the Independent Planning Commission are putting local businesses at risk.

There are 40,000 people working in mining in NSW including 23,000 coal miners who rely on mining for their livelihood.

These problems go beyond mining and potentially affect other industries seeking to invest and create jobs in NSW.
